

Use of the Hall for Children's Parties

- Please leave the hall tidy as indicated in the hiring agreement.
- Please make sure all the lights are turned off before departure including those on the stairs, in the toilets and in the corridor.
- Please remember to lock the hall doors after use and return the key to the key safe.
